CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING (CMHC) PROGRAM

In this reporting period (through Spring 2019) 14 students graduated. The overall completion rate within the expected time frame is 100% for this group of recent graduates. This completion rate includes both CMHC students and Dual students (these complete both the CMHC and SC programs). The overall completion rate within the expected time frame for the CMHC program alone and for the Dual (both CMHC and SC programs) is 100%. In the current reporting period, the number of years to complete the CMHC program has varied from 2.7 years to 3.0 years with an average of 2.5 years, and the number of years to complete the Dual (both CMHC and SC programs) is 3 years with an average of 3 years. The Counseling and Human Development program does not operate on a strict cohort model and accommodates both full-time and part-time students. Most students work full-time while they are in the program and thus their student status (full-time vs part-time) may vary from semester to semester. Those who start as full-time students and wish to maintain employment, becomes part-time students during Practicum and Internship. CMHC (including Dual) students have an 83% pass rate on the NCE for initial licensure. The job placement rate for CMHC (and Dual) students actively looking for employment over the last 180 days is 100%; this includes those who graduated in May, 2019.

SCHOOL COUNSELING (SC) PROGRAM

In this reporting period (through Spring 2019) 10 students graduated. The completion rate within the expected time frame is 80% for this group of recent graduates (there were two students that took breaks in their academic program). In the current reporting period, the number of years to complete the SC program has varied from 1.7 to 2.3 years, with an average of 2 years (excluding the two students who took academic breaks). The Counseling and Human Development program does not operate on a strict cohort model and accommodates both full-time and part-time students. Most students work full-time while they are in the program and thus their student status (full-time vs part-time) may vary from semester to semester. Those who start as full-time students and wish to maintain employment, become part-time during Practicum and Internship. The pass rate for the ODE in 2018-2019 is 92%. The job placement rate for SC students graduating in December 2018 is 100% and for the SC students graduating in May 2019 is 44%.
