Representatives from Stellic visited campus at the beginning of April to provide training for The Office of the Registrar and the Office of Advising for Student Success training as we prepare for the Stellic launch. Both offices are actively working on building audits and pathways for Walsh's academic programs. For faculty advisors, Stellic's audits, pathways, and additional features will streamline routine tasks, allowing for meaningful advising and personalized student support.

SOME of what Stellic offers advisors:

- Clear visibility into a student's progress toward their degree, including completed and outstanding requirements
- Alerts for students who may be at risk, such as those with low grades or who have not registered for required courses
- A centralized system for advising notes and referrals, ensuring continuity of communication when a student changes advisors

- CRN (required only for existing courses, not needed for new courses)
- Subject code and course number
- **Schedule type/instructional type ***
- **Instructional method/modality ***
- Part of term
- Meeting days and times
- Instructor

***Schedule type/instructional type and Instructional method/modality are new edits that we have added. ALL courses must include both a schedule type and an instructional method. The schedule type indicates the type of course while the instructional modality explains how it will be delivered.**

- Lab (B)
- Internship (N)
- Practicum (PR)
- Clinical (CL)
- Capstone (CAP)
- Seminar (S)
- Integrated Lecture/Lab (LEL)

Instructional Methods:

- Online Synchronous (OS)
- Online Blended (OB)
- Campus Hybrid (CH)
- Remote Hybrid (RH)
