## **ADVISING REMINDERS**

The Office of the Registrar conducts degree audits for students who have applied to graduate. During this review process, we have identified several common advising errors:

**Courses With Designations:** Students are required to take Foundations (FD) coursework, as well as courses designated Cultural Humility (CH), Service Learning (SL) and Catholic Intellectual Tradition (CH). Please make sure that courses are labeled with the correct designations for each category when advising students and helping them fulfill their Gen Ed requirements.

**Exploratory Themes (TH1, TH2 and TH3):** Students must select two of the three themes and complete six credit hours in each. During advising, confirm that each student has chosen two different themes with six credits earned in each theme.

**GE 400 Senior Seminar:** This course is required as part of the Gen Ed Curriculum. Please take a look at the <u>General Education Curriculum</u> in the <u>Walsh University Catalog</u>.

**Course Substitutions:** If a course substitution is required, please have the student submit a <u>Course Substitution Request</u> E-form. The form will be routed for approval and recorded by the Office of the Registrar.

Repeating Courses: Students may repeat any course taken at Walsh University. There may be limits by individual divisions set on the number of times a course may be repeated in the major. Credit for a course will only be awarded once and only one course is counted toward graduation requirements. You can view the entire Repeating Courses
